# UT reports three Covid deaths, toll reaches 258

CHANDIGARH, NOVEMBER 21

HE UT on Saturday reported 119 new Covid-19 positive cases, taking the total tally of cases in Chandigarh to 16,591. The active cases are now 1,135 and deaths are 258, with three deaths reported on Saturday.

The number of samples tested in the last 24 hours is 1210 and the total number of samples tested till now is 1,31,280. As many as 102 people were discharged from various facilities.

A 45-year-old woman, a resident of Sector 29, a case of type 2 diabetes mellitus and acute kidney injury, who tested positive, expired at City Hospital, Chandigarh and a 61-year-old man, a resident of Maloya, a case of acute kidney injury and liver disease with complications, who tested positive, expired at JMCER. A 79-year-old woman, a resident of Sector 34, expired at City Hospital, Mohali.

As per the latest available data, 971 out of every 10 lakh people in Chandigarh have tested positive for the virus. The active ratio is 6.8 per cent, for every 100 confirmed cases, 7 are currently infected. The case fatality ratio is 1.5 per cent. For every 10 lakh people in Chandigarh, 110,322 samples are tested. The average growth rate of the disease in Chandigarh is 1.5 per cent. In the last one week, the number of new Covid-19 infections has grown by an average of 0.7 per cent every day. The recovery ratio is 91.6 per cent. For every 100 confirmed cases, 92 are recovered from the virus.

## 3 deaths, 117 new cases in Mohali

**Mohali:** Mohali district reported three Covid-19 deaths and 117 new positive Saturday. As many as 67 new patients are from Mohali (Urban) and 33 are from Kharar. At least five new cases were found in Dhakoli and one each in Bhutgarh and Derabassi, respectively.

Meanwhile, 93 patients were cured and discharged from different hospitals.

A total of 14,300 persons have tested positive for coronavirus in the district. A total of 12,769 have been cured and as many as 1,265 are active. At least 266 people have succumbed to Covid-19 here. **ENS**

## Panchkula CMO among 90 new coronavirus cases in district

**Panchkula:** As many as 90 new Covid cases and no deaths were reported in Panchkula district on Saturday. Among the new cases was Panchkula CMO who was "mildly symptomatic".

The number of active cases stood at 505 on Saturday -- the highest in more than 45 days. With the spike in active cases, the recovery rate which had touched 96 per cent in the last week of October dropped to 92.4 per cent on Saturday.

Of the 90 new cases, while 62 belonged to the district itself, the rest were added to the outside district tally. The active cases Saturday stood at 505 while as many as 7,644 have been cured

and discharged. As many as 165 healthcare workers have been infected in Panchkula so far. At least two healthcare workers, including Panchkula CMO, tested positive Saturday. "I am mildly symptomatic and in home isolation. Will continue to fight Covid from home for a few days," she said.

A total of 8,270 positive cases have been reported in the district with an added 2,603 people testing positive from other districts as well. As many as 121 have also succumbed to the disease in the district. The district has conducted 1,04,671 tests so far. A total of 947 samples were collected by the district on Saturday.

## Juvenile raptor flying at low

A JUVENILE Himalayan Griffon vulture flying at low height collided with a TV cable in a slum area, Kacchi Colony, at Dhanas, behind Panjab University campus on Saturday. The raptor was rescued by a local couple, who sheltered it inside their house for around an hour. Wildlife wing officials said that most likely, the juvenile raptor had mistakenly lost its way and got separated from its colony.

Ajay Bahat, who rescued the vulture and kept it inside his house, said, "In the melee, the raptor hit its nib on my left hand. From the size of the bird, I realised that it was not a mature bird. However, it was very tough to keep the bird inside the house. The bird almost created a havoc inside

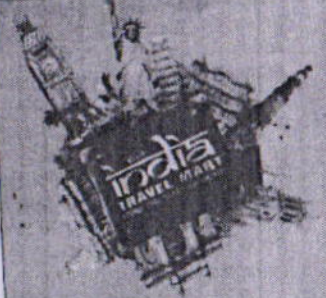
